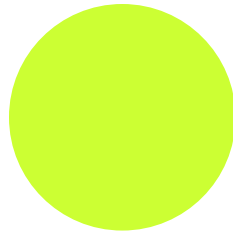

2017 Juried Student Art Exhibit

The gallery sponsors a combined juried student art exhibit in May. Schools invited to participate include Legacy High School, Century High School, Bismarck High School, Shiloh Christian School, Mandan High School, South Central High School, and Dakota Adventist Academy students.

How to Enter

Art teachers will jury their own students artwork for exhibition. The gallery will only accommodate 150 pieces of artwork. Students are limited to two pieces of artwork. Teachers may not select more than two pieces of artwork from an individual student. The number of artwork from each school is listed below and is based on the school art class populations.

Entry Fee

The entry fee is \$3.00 per entry and must be collected by the teacher at the time of entry. The art teacher will pay collected entry fees from students to BAGA.

Accepted Media

Entries shall be fine art and should be for sale. Acceptable media includes: mixed media, illustrations, computer generated art, drawing, painting, photography, original prints, pottery and sculpture. All work must be original and completed within the last two years. Students may enter no more than two pieces and size is limited to 18x24 in size including the mat and frame.

Juror, Andrea Fagerstrom

The juror for the 2017 show Andrea Fagerstrom will jury the artwork at BAGA for awards and prizes.

About the Juror

Andrea Fagerstrom is a Visual Arts Instructor and the Art Gallery Coordinator at Bismarck State College. Fagerstrom earned a Bachelor of Fine Arts from the North Dakota State University and is currently completing a Masters of Integrated Arts and Education from the University of Montana-Missoula.

Andrea is currently serving on the board of the North Dakota Art Gallery Association (NDAGA) and is a member of BAGA. She is also an annually returning guest artist in the classroom at Jeannette Myhre Elementary in Bismarck. Andrea enjoys advocating for the Arts and Humanities in the Bismarck/Mandan area and seeing them flourish with each passing year.

Guidelines for Accepted Student Artwork

- All works must have either a mat and frame or be a wrapped canvas with finished edges for the exhibit.
- All artwork must be finished with wire hangers on the back. No saw tooth hangers, string or stick-on hangers are allowed.
- All work must be labeled with Artist's Name, School, Title, Media and Price
- The jurist will select 10 entries for cash awards.
- All artwork must be original. Images must not be recognizable from other published images subject to copyright law. For example, students must take their own reference photos and they should not be from published magazines or websites subject to

Teacher Responsibility for Accepted Entries

Teachers are responsible for supplying BAGA with the correct information on all student work. A fillable form will be supplied to all teachers for this purpose. All work exhibited in the Student Exhibit shall be listed in the supplied table form.
